

GRAND MASTER'S PROCLAMATION OF NOVEMBER 8, 2012

This Proclamation was read at the December 13, 2012 annual stated communication which directed this information on Masonic Recognition Day by communicated to every Mason in Virginia by whatever means the Lodge deems appropriate, but no later than sixty (60) days after receipt of this proclamation.

“WHEREAS, for many years, Freemasons have endeavored to achieve a level of recognition within their respective communities, and

WHEREAS, this activity has taken many forms and produced a like number of programs and some success has been achieved, and

WHEREAS, continuous and on-going displays of our Masonic membership will forever engrave a lasting memory in the minds of friends and associates of our commitment to our Brothers, our Lodges and, more importantly, our way of life,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Louis K. Campbell, Grand Master of Masons in Virginia, desiring the Masons in Virginia to be more pro-active in this area, do hereby proclaim that all Lodges holden under this Grand Lodge shall observe Masonic Recognition Day on the first day of each month. This recognition should take the form of wearing of Masonic apparel such as hats, shirts, jackets, belts, etc. Further, each Mason is encouraged to hold every day as Masonic Recognition Day by studying a portion of the Methodical Digest, Presentation Volume, other Masonic books or pamphlets, and the Volume of Sacred Law, as well as hold discussions with well-informed Brethren that his actions may conform to the most favorable kinds of public recognition. This recognition is not limited to Craft, or symbolic recognition, but is meant to include all appendant organization of the Masonic family, including the youth organizations.”

Brethren,

In 1985 Lake Drummond Lodge moved from Afton Parkway in Cradock to Deep Creek. This would not have been possible without the financial and physical help of the members of Lake Drummond Lodge. Lake Drummond would not be able to do the things we have done without your help and without putting a large financial burden on the lodge. Lake Drummond has been debt free on the property for quite some time.

A few years ago we saw a need for our elderly members to be able to use the restroom facilities without going back inside when we had our picnics, barbecue's and fish fry's outside. Again through your efforts both financial and labor skills we were able to build two tiled bathrooms outside for under \$6000 dollars. Had we contracted this job out it would have cost the lodge some \$30,000 dollars to accomplish.

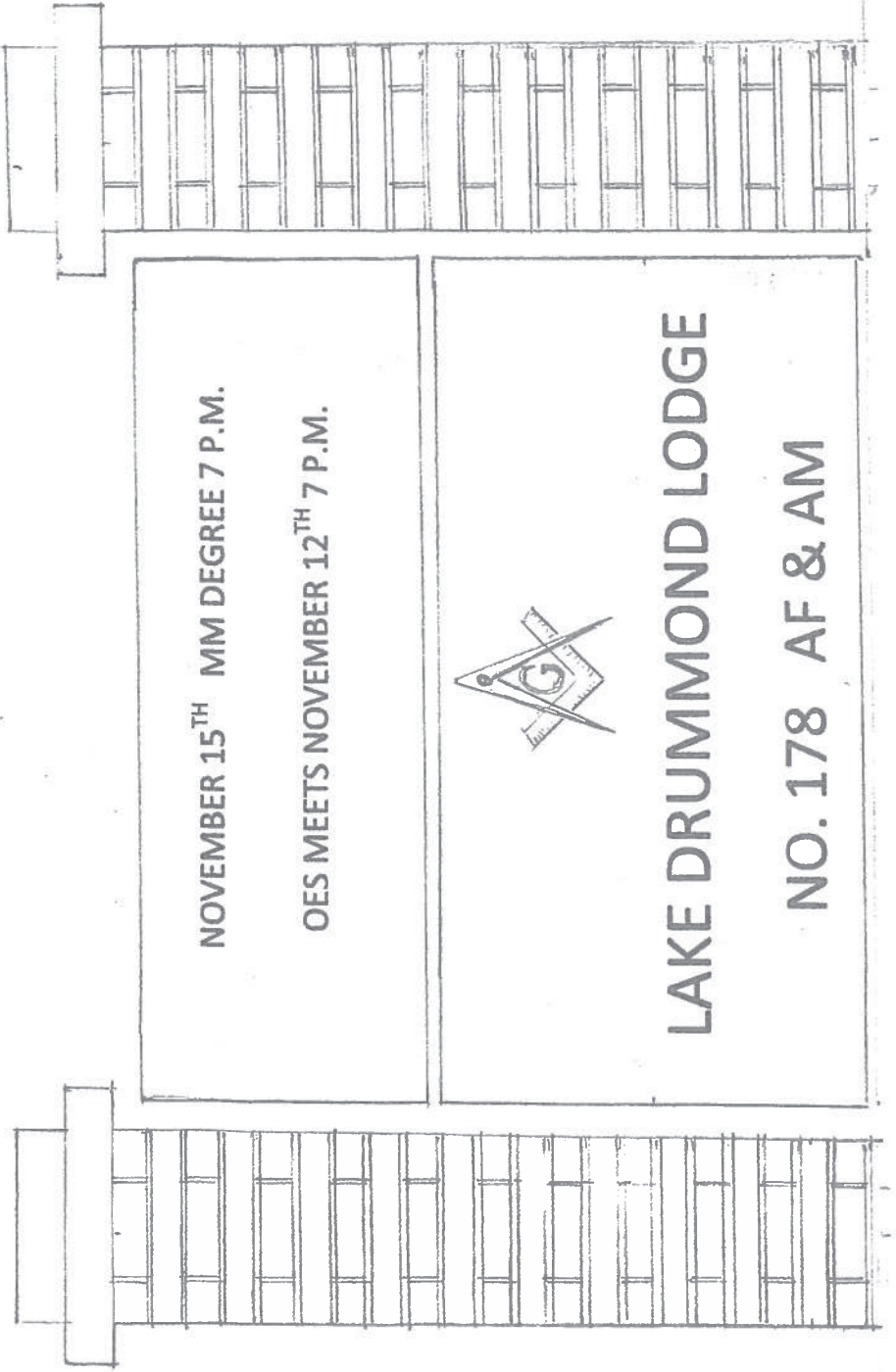
The lodge has not had any major renovations other than the bathrooms since it was built in 1985. This past December the lodge installed a new porcelain tile floor in the social hall again through the help of the brethren we were able to do this at a low cost. We had determined it would not be feasible to install carpet for the third time. Carpet would not hold up to the traffic we have today. Originally vinyl tile was installed when the lodge was built. It too did not function well. The tile in the front foyer is porcelain and has held up well since 1985 hence the influence to use porcelain tile in the social hall.

Lake Drummond has been quite successful over the past few years in our fund raisers to support the lodge expenses. However, this past year we were not as successful as we had been in the past. Lake Drummond has always done well with community support in there barbecues and fish fry's, they are very popular. In the past we have used portable signs to advertise these fund raisers. These signs are expensive even though they are portable. When you think of portable they must be light in weight, thus the problem with portable signs. In the past two years the lodge has had two of these portable signs destroyed by high winds. As a result of the last sign being destroyed we did not have a suitable sign to advertise our fish fry. As a result of this, the fish fry suffered financially.

It is the desire of the Board of Trustees with your help to install a permanent electronic sign that can be programed with any message the lodge desires at any time. This sign can be used to let people know when we meet and what we are doing (so much for our secrets). It could possibly be used in "Amber Alerts". The type of sign we are proposing to have is similar to what you see at your local pharmacies. They are expensive but we believe they will be a good long term investment, and may even create some interest for bringing light to new members.

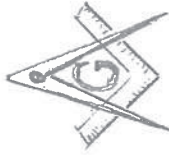
Brethren we are asking for your help in this great undertaking to raise approximately \$14,000.
