GRAND MASTER'S PROCLAMATION OF NOVEMBER 11, 2013

This Proclamation was read at the December 12, 2013 annual stated communication which directed this information on Masonic Recognition Day be communicated to every Mason in Virginia by whatever means the Lodge deems appropriate, but no later than sixty (60) days after receipt of this proclamation.

"WHEREAS, for many years, Freemasons have endeavored to achieve a level of recognition within their respective communities, and

WHEREAS, this activity has taken many forms and produced a like number of programs and some success has been achieved, and

WHEREAS, continuous and on-going displays of our Masonic membership will forever engrave a lasting memory in the minds of friends and associates of our commitment to our Brothers, our Lodges and, more importantly, our way of life,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wayne S. Flora, Grand Master of Masons in Virginia, desiring the Masons in Virginia to be more pro-active in this area, do hereby proclaim that all Lodges holden under this Grand Lodge shall observe Masonic Recognition Day on the first day of each month. This recognition should take the form of wearing of Masonic apparel such as hats, shirts, jackets, belts, etc. Further, each Mason is encouraged to hold every day as Masonic Recognition Day by studying a portion of the Methodical Digest, Presentation Volume, other Masonic books or pamphlets, and the Volume of Sacred Law, as well as hold discussions with well-informed Brethren that his actions may conform to the most favorable kinds of public recognition. This recognition is not limited to Craft, or symbolic recognition, but is meant to include all appendant organization of the Masonic family, including the youth organizations."

APPEAL FOR RELIEF – THE PHILIPPINES

The following information was contained in a Memo to All Grand Secretaries of North America from the Executive Secretary, George O. Braatz, P.G.M., Masonic Service Association of North America dated November 14, 2013;

The news media has communicated the enormous damage caused by Typhoon Haiyan to the Philippines on November 8. While it is too soon to determine the final extent of the loss of life and destruction of buildings, we know the suffering is extensive and will be long lasting.

The Masonic Service Association has made initial contact with the Grand Lodge of the Philippines, and they have asked for this Disaster Relief Appeal to be made. Although we were unable to receive any information on the losses that might have occurred to Masons or Lodges, we do know, from our "List of Lodges," that there are Lodges operating in Tacloban City and Cebu City, and perhaps other cities, that were in the direct path of the storm.
